Making Effective Use of School and Curriculum Planning Templates

Curriculum Support for Catholic Schools: Enhancing the Religious Dimension of Catholic Schools becomes a practical tool for Catholic educators through use of its School and Curriculum Planning Templates. To use these templates effectively, users need to move between Template, CD and online Ministry expectations.

Here are some helpful hints...

1. Open the *Curriculum Support for Catholic Schools* CD on your computer. Bring up the *template* of your choice; copy and paste it into your word processing program (don't forget to name and save it).
2. Go to www.ocup.org or www.tcdsb.org/ice or www.curriculum.org for course profiles or units that match the subject and grade you are working on. Follow the links to your unit and find its corresponding ministry expectations. You will need to highlight, copy and paste these into your template.
3. You should have all three documents (CD, Course Profile/Unit, Template) open. Working in your template, copy and paste from the other two documents, inserting what is needed into the template (see below) until you have arrived at the end:
