Process Stages	Details and Considerations
September/October	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Meet with the Pastoral Team to explore the needs of staff vis-à-vis adult faith development • Examine practical issues (e.g. planning the in-school faith day, the possibility of a twilight retreat for staff, using some time at staff meetings for adult faith development, opportunities for staff to come together for prayer, budget)
October	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Present to staff the Ongoing Adult Faith Development Plan for the year
October/June	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Implement plan
June	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Evaluate and begin planning for following year
